



How can I
help my child
SUCCEED
in school?

- Stay involved and feel free to contact your child's teacher with any questions or concerns. If possible, peruse the class website weekly to stay up to date on classroom activities. Ask your child daily for notes or papers from the teacher.
- Ask your children about school and encourage them to talk about their day.
- Read with your child every night.
- Help your child with his/her homework every night.
- Teach your children to be responsible for their actions and their schoolwork, including bringing home notes /agenda for parents to read.

How can I
help my
child with
Math?

Remind your child to study for tests and quizzes.

- Make sure your child is getting plenty of sleep and is ready for school each day- With supplies, homework, lunch or lunch money, and a positive attitude!
- Do not talk negatively about your child's teacher or school.
- Help your child learn math vocabulary. Use index cards to create a matching game.
- Give your child coins to practice counting money.
- Help your child practice math facts, addition and subtraction to 20, to help build fluency.
- Show your child that math is in our everyday lives.

- Give your child story problems to try and solve. Have your child explain how to solve the problem.
- Help your child practice telling time on an analog clock, and count the minutes between the numerals.
- Let your child help you cook. Cooking involves a lot of counting and measuring.
